## SGSM retained the OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIPS Title.

At the 36th Asean Senior Amateur Golf Championships, hosted by the Indonesian Senior Golfers' Society, from 24th to 26th September 2018, SGSM proudly retained the Overall Championships Title. This meant that SGSM won handsomely The Lela Pahlawan Trophy by amassing 48 points and beating the Thailand Senior Golfers' Association by 2 Points. SGSM won the same title at the 35th Asean Senior Amateur Golf Championships in the Philippines last year after a lapse of 10 years. Kudos SGSM for the achievement.

A total of 76 from Malaysia travelled to Jakarta as participants, supporters and spouses. The Vice President, Dato' Khalid Ismail was the Chef-de-Mission.

SGSM sent a contingent of 23 players in the Stroke category and 22 players in the Stableford category. In order to win the Overall Championships, a participating Senior Golfers Association in the championships must gather as many points as possible by accumulating points awarded to the Team Gross, Team Nett, Team Stableford and the top six individual winners in the gross, nett and the Stableford competitions.

The event was held at the Rancamaya Golf and Country Club and the Pondok Indah Golf and Country Club in Jakarta.
